



DEDICATION

STATE OF FLORIDA

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS

That ORRIN COFFRIN and RALPH TOWNSEND, joined by his wife VERA A. TOWNSEND, owners in fee simple of the tract of land shown on this plat and described as: THE WEST SIX HUNDRED EIGHTEEN AND $\frac{1}{2}$ FEET OF FRACTIONAL SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST have caused said land to be surveyed and plotted and do hereby dedicate for the perpetual use of the public as public highways the streets shown hereon, reserving unto themselves the reversion and reversions thereof whenever the same shall be abandoned by the public or discontinued by law.
