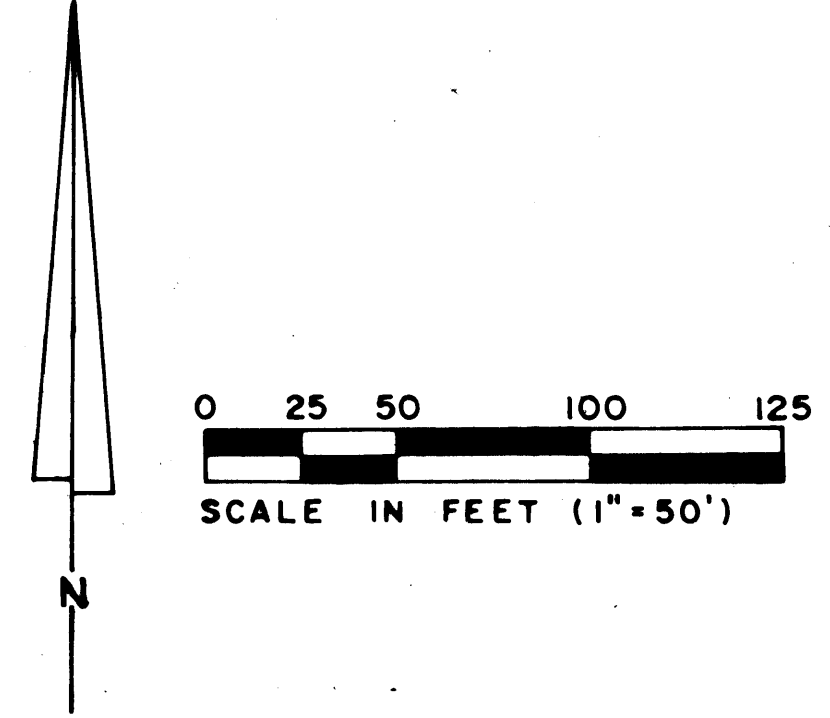
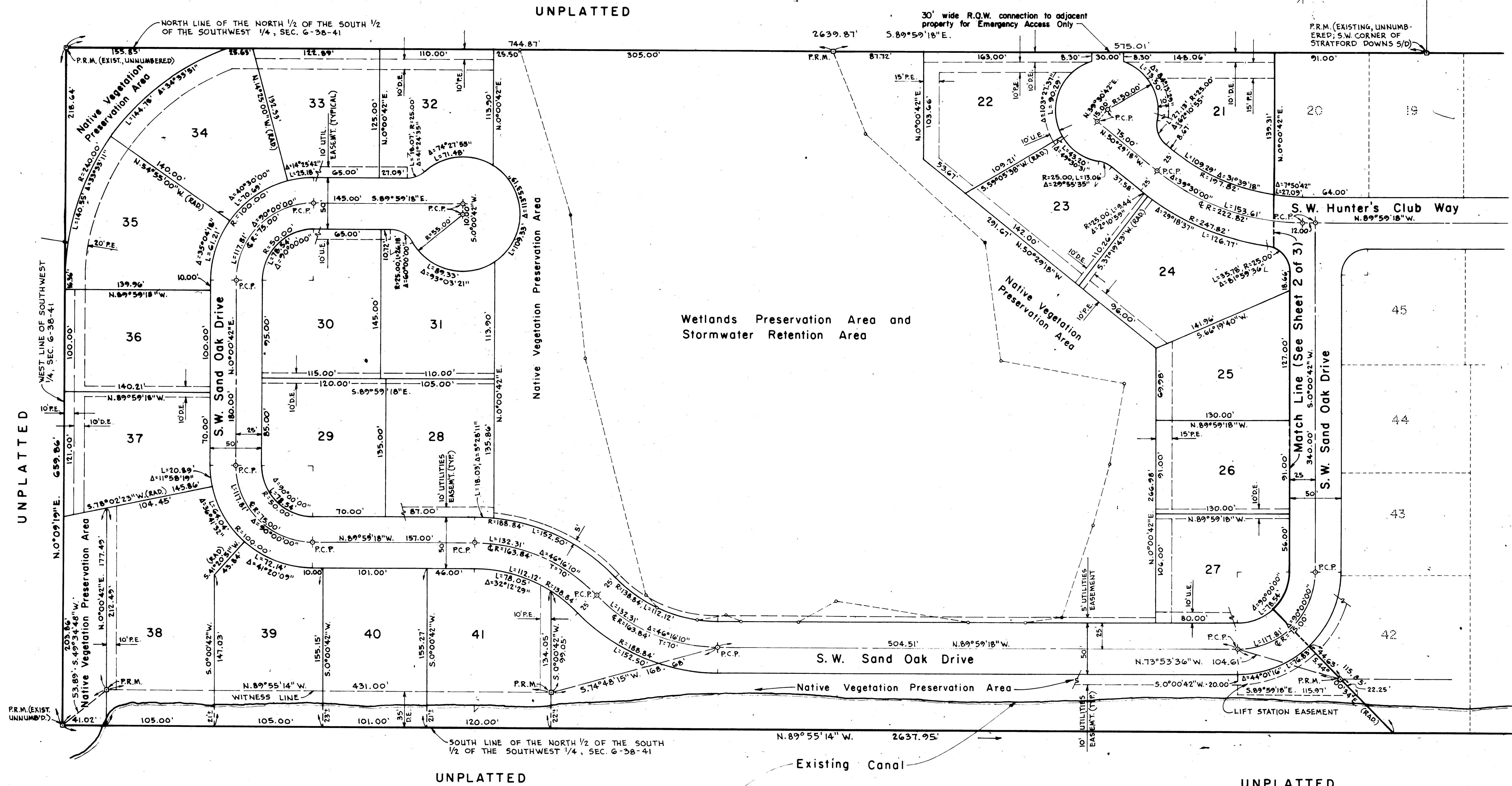

There shall be no buildings or other permanent structures placed on utility easements. There shall be no lot splits except to create larger lots. There shall be a 10 foot wide utilities easement adjacent to road rights of way except where otherwise shown.

NOTICE: There may be additional restrictions that are not recorded on this plat that may be found in the public records of this county.
