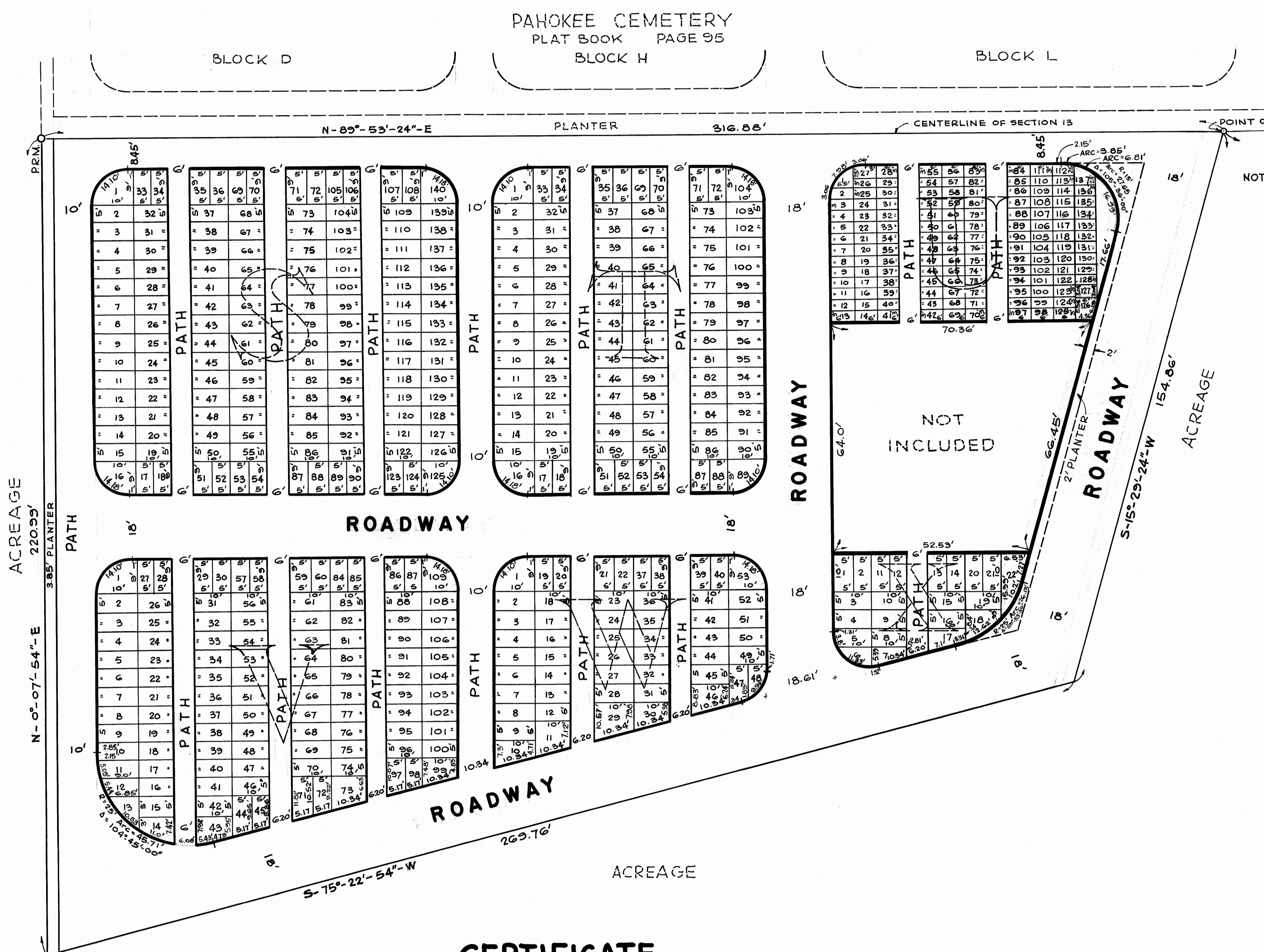

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that the Board of Trustees of the Port Mayaca Cemetery, a quasi-political body located in Palm Beach County, Florida, the owner in fee simple of that tract of land lying and being in Martin County, Florida, shown on the attached plat as the First Addition to Port Mayaca Cemetery, and more particularly described as follows: Commence at the East Quarter Corner of Section 13, Township 40 South, Range 37 East; thence westerly on an assumed bearing of South-89°-53'-24"-West along the centerline of said Section 13 a distance of 135.97' to the Point of Beginning; thence South-89°-53'-24"-West a distance of 316.88'; thence South-0°-07'-54"-West a distance of 220.99'; thence North-75°-22'-54"-East a distance of 269.76'; thence North-15°-29'-24"-East a distance of 154.86' to the Point of Beginning; has caused the same to be surveyed and platted as shown hereon, and does hereby dedicate to the perpetual use of the public all the roadways, paths, planting areas as shown hereon.
